# Postgraduate Training in Supervision Diploma in Supervision

*A one-year part-time programme*

The provision of high quality supervision is now, more than ever a high priority for Training Organisations, especially those registered with accrediting bodies. Many statutory and voluntary organisations look for suitably trained and qualified supervisors to support the work of the practitioner.

This programme of 18 days' training offers a Diploma in Supervision from one of the largest UKCP accrediting organisations.

This course is suitable for those wishing to expand their current skills and knowledge in working with people in a supervisory capacity. It is suitable for those wishing to incorporate new knowledge and skills, or to expand their current work role, or for those wishing to introduce or to enhance supervision within private practice.

The course is based on both a relational and a developmental approach, and includes:

- Creating an effective working alliance.
- The learning styles of supervisees.
- Styles of interventions – which ones suit which supervisees.
- Parallel process in supervision, including transference, counter-transference and projective identification.
- Advanced ethical issues.

### **Entrance Requirements**

A Qualification at an equivalent level to UKCP registered psychotherapist or BACP registered counsellor, plus two years of post-qualification experience is usually necessary.

### 2011-12 Tuition Fees

The tuition fee is **£1914** (*Fees can be paid by standing order in 6 bi-monthly instalments*)



### Clinical Requirements

Students for the Diploma are required to receive:

- a) a minimum of **25 hours** supervision of their work as a supervisor, from an accredited Supervisor

And Students for the Diploma are required to provide:

- b) a minimum of **50 hours** supervision of supervisees.

These two criteria must be completed prior to submission of the written component for the required completion of the training.

### External examination / marking fees

These fees are charged separately at the point of submission.

The **2011/12** rate is **£85** per component.
