Complaints Assistance


While we hope that you will never be the subject of a complaint in relation to your professional conduct, this is an ever-increasing reality of our professional context. Complaints about UKCP members have historically been dealt with by their member organisation, but SPTI is now signed up to the UKCP central complaints process which means that any complaints relating to SPTI members will be dealt with directly via UKCP.

This separation from the complaints process means that, in case of a complaint, you would be able to access an initial consultation with a member of SPTI's ethics committee to ensure your understanding of the process and help you to find appropriate support. SPTI Management and senior members will also be freed up to offer independent consultation to those graduate members who have to go through this distressing experience, thereby ensuring that emotional and pastoral support is available.



SPTI maintains a "Find a Therapist/Find a Supervisor" directory on our website which is regularly used by members of the public who are searching for therapists, and professionals who are searching for supervisors.

This search area offers members who are accredited with UKCP or BACP an advertising forum to publicise their therapy or supervisory services to our graduate and student community and to the public.

Library & Moodle Access

SPTI policy has been to maintain the membership fee at a reasonable level. Please help us to continue this policy by paying your membership fee on or before the due date.

Regrettably we will have to levy a 10% additional charge for late fees up to three weeks beyond the due date and 20% for late fees four weeks beyond the due date. This is to cover costs of additional administration. After 8 weeks' membership will automatically expire – lapsed membership periods will need to be fully paid before UKCP re-accreditation can be undertaken.
